Agreement between Pennsylvania MESA and _____ School

Your school agrees to provide:

VISION: A leader who is enthusiastic about STEM education

SPACE: A consistent space for MESA meetings during or after school for 2-4 hours per week

COACH: A certified teacher or super engaged volunteer to serve as the MESA Advisor/Coach

ENCOURAGEMENT: Make announcements about upcoming competitions!
